Recipe of the Month Corn off the Cob In a large bowl, whisk together 1 teaspoon lime zest, 7 tablespoons lime juice, 1 teaspoon sugar, 1 teaspoon kosher salt and a dash of hot sauce. While whisking, slowly pour in 7 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil and continue whisking until emulsified. Set dressing aside. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil. Working in batches as necessary, add 8 ears fresh sweet corn, shucked and boil until tender, about 4 minutes. Drain. As soon as corn is cool enough to handle, cut kernels off cobs and place kernels in bowl with dressing. Add 1 cup finely chopped red onion and ½ cup chopped fresh cilantro; toss to combine. Cover and refrigerate until needed. Serve cold or at room temperature.
