Recipe of the Month *Pot Pie Filling* Take 2 large chicken breast and dice into bite size pieces. Fry these in a large cast iron skillet in 2 tbs each of butter and oil. Take chicken out of pan and set aside when cooked to 165 degrees. In same pan leave 1 tbs of oil-butter mix 8 ounces of mushrooms and cook 3-5 minutes. Then add 1 ½ cups of each carrots and corn. Fry until not quite soft. Mix the chicken in and add 24 ounces of chicken gravy. Simmer until hot. Serve over rice, biscuits or potatoes. Serves 6 or 7 people.
