Recipe of the Month *Chicken and Broccoli Bubble Up* Preheat your oven to 350 degrees F. Spray a 9x13-inch baking pan with non-stick spray. Open 1 can of Pillsbury™ Grands!™ Flaky Layers refrigerated Original biscuits and remove biscuits from can. Cut each biscuit into 8 pieces. Spread biscuit pieces evenly in the bottom of prepared pan.
