Recipe of the Month Crock Pot Wild Turkey Spray Crockpot with nonstick cooking spray. Combine 2 pounds of browned turkey burger, cooked 2 pounds frozen corn, 2 14-ounce cans black beans 2 28-ounce cans plus 1-15-ounce can crushed tomatoes in a mixing bowl and beat with an electric mixer on medium speed for 2 minutes.
