Recipe of the Month *Grilled Corn on the Cob w/Chesapeake Bay Butter:*

In Large pot stir ½ cup salt in 4 quarts of cold water until dissolved add 8 ears of husked silk removed corn and soak for 30 minutes. Grill corn over hot fire turning every 2 to 3 minutes until kernels are lightly charred all over. Remove from grill and brush with Chesapeake Bay butter- Using fork beat 8 tbs softened unsalted butter with 1 tbs hot sauce 1tsp Old Bay seasoning and 1 minced garlic clove.
