1. Marksmen's Paradise – Any gun, any rest, any shooting position. 10 shots, 3 @ 100 yards, 3 @ 200 yards, 3 @ 300 yards and 1 @ a clay bird between 2 and 3 hundred yards.

Erle Fisk with 156 Points

2. Freehand Fanatic – Any gun, 16 shots, 5 @ 50 yards standing freehand. 5 @ 100 yards leaning off post. 5 @ 100 yards sitting, prone or handicap position if can't do sitting or prone. 1 shot at 200 yards off bench supported by hands only.

3. Spray the Steel – AR only, 2 divisions, same course of fire for both. Division 1, open sights, or non-magnified red dot. Division 2, scoped. 5 steels at 50 yards, 5 steels at 100 yards, 5 shots on paper at 100 yards. Unlimited shots on steels, must have a hit on all the steels before shooting paper. 10 points per steel all shot offhand, 1 point deducted for each miss.

<u>**Cold Bore Shoot**</u> Here we go again another cold bore shoot this Saturday March 30th from 10 am to 3 pm. There will be a 200-yard, one shot with a rifle under 9 pounds and up to a 14-power scope. Also, a 300-yard, one shot with any rifle. Let's gitty-up and give us your best shot! <u>Recipe of the Month</u> Juicy Easter Ham Preheat oven to 325°. Wrap your Spiral Sliced Ham (bone in) completely before placing it in a baking dish with Aluminum foil. Place wrapped ham in a baking pan that will give stability. Bake your ham covered for 20 minutes per pound for bone-in. As the ham is in the oven cooking, it's time to make your glaze. In a small bowl mix ¹/₂ Cup Jellied Cranberry Sauce, ¹/₂ Cup your favorite BBQ Sauce, 2 TBSP Honey. Uncover the ham 30-45 minutes before completion and put your glaze on the ham.
