Recipe of the Month *Baked Crispy Walleye* Combine 1/3 cup dry bread crumbs, 1/3 cup instant mashed potato flakes, and 1/3 cup grated Parmesan cheese in a separate bowl with 1 teaspoon seasoned salt until evenly mixed. Beat 2 eggs and 1 tablespoon water together in a bowl until smooth; set aside. Preheat the oven to 450 degrees F (230 degrees C). Grease a baking sheet. Dip 4 (4 ounce) fillets walleye into beaten egg, then press into bread crumb mixture. Place onto the prepared baking sheet. Bake in the preheated oven until fish is opaque in the center and flakes easily with a fork, 15 to 20 minutes.
