Add the 2 together and the shooter with the smallest combined score wins. Use any shooting position or rest you want, and you get 15 minutes to shoot it.

Recipe of the Month *BBQ SQUIRREL* Preheat oven to 350F. Cut up 4 whole, small squirrels, Coat meat with a nice layer of olive oil, 2-3 Tablespoons. Sprinkle with your BBQ rub of choice and lay the meat in a single layer in a baking pan. Bake those bad boys for 30 minutes. Combine 2 cups of barbecue sauce, 3 cloves of garlic, minced and 1 ½ teaspoons toasted sesame oil and brush this on meat to taste. Bake for another 30-60 minutes or until meat is tender and can be pulled from the bone. Finish by basting with as much sauce as your heart desires, and don't be afraid to get messy with it! I mean it is BBQ after all.
